Presentation of Evidence	Lacks visual organization or attention to detail. Uses no coherent method to present overall learning.	Visual organization/layout is evident. Coherent presentation clearly organizes student's learning and accurately reflects self-knowledge.	Presents portfolio in original/ imaginative way, using an overall organizing concept, and clearly shows personal growth.
Selection of Evidence	Student has not used class and/or home time to work on portfolio. Evidence chosen shows little effort or consideration to select appropriate "evidence of learning".	Good use of class/home time to prepare presentation. Evidence selection enhances student's overall understanding of his/her learning.	Student has put extra effort/care into presentation and demonstrates an exceptional level of consideration for appropriate evidence required to express his/her learning.
