Visual appeal/organization

- Tell me about your presentation format.
- What theme or visual metaphor did you use to plan your portfolio?
- How does your portfolio reflect your learning/experience at MacNeill this year?
- What do you want to communicate in your presentation?
- How do you want your audience to respond to your presentation?

Effort

- How much time and energy have you put into preparing for your presentation?
- How much did you practice?
- What kind of feedback from your friends, parents and teachers have you incorporated into your presentation?

Content

- What is there about your portfolio that you are most proud of?
- How does your evidence show who you are?
- What are the personal connections that your portfolio represents?
- What were the reasons for what you chose to present?

Personal reflection

- What have you learned from completing your portfolio this year?
- How can you describe your learning in your own words?
- What does your portfolio mean to you?
- How do you see your portfolio learning helping you make choices in the future?
- What are your plans for next year? What will you focus on, and why?
